

Identification in Redemption

You see, man is a spirit being, God is a spirit being, and Satan is a spirit being. That is one thing we have to come to realise. It's not when I hear people pray, Satan die, die, die, die. Spirit beings don't die. That's the wrong concept of prayers. I see some people sweating, and they burn the energy in the name of praying. Demons die. Demons don't die. They are spirit being. Satan dies. Satan doesn't die. That's a spirit being. Man should die. Man cannot die. It is the body that can die. Man is a spirit being it has a soul and live in a body. It is the physical being of a man that you can say can die, but the real man, the one that is speaking to you right now, can never die. It is a spirit being. That's why I don't pray as a person, that my enemy should die, how will they see the power and the glory of God in my life on redemption? I want them to be alive.

On this note, I welcome you again as I continue my promise of teaching through this month of redemption. Welcome again to April, the month of redemption. Jesus being our redemption and who has redeemed us? To God. So, we can share in the inheritance of life that we once had that we lost in our life. I want to share what I call identification. It's very important in this solid foundation we're trying to lay in this month of April. There are sources you want to build upon it in terms of whatever you become in life. In leadership, in government, or in entrepreneurship, in career, in marriage. Name it. You have, as a child, you have a solid foundation. You are building. When you build a skyscraper, the

foundation is already very solid. It's deeper underground, than it is as you can see. Because the load you're going to carry. You don't build a skyscraper on a shallow foundation. Jesus is our foundation, and no other foundation can anybody lay, except that which God has laid for us in Christ Jesus. It's our redemption. In the book of Genesis, it says this seed that the woman will bring will bruise the head of Satan. There's a reason for that. So, I want to bring you to that Word of God as I lay some few things. So that it helps you to know what Satan did to us. What happened and what God has done for us. So, I'm looking at identification. On that, I'm looking at the two sides of redemption. Towards God's side and Satan's side. You can make a choice afterwards. I'm on God's side. So, in **1 Corinthians 3, from verse 11**, the Bible says, *“For other foundations can no man lay when that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. But if any man builds upon this foundation, gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble, every man's work shall be made manifest. For the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire. And the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built upon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be born, he shall suffer loss. He himself shall be saved, yet so as by fire”*.

If your foundation is not Jesus Christ, it's built on things. Built on sacrifice, built on religion, built on denomination and not on Jesus Christ as a foundation. It's going to be a day, every man's work on the face of the earth will be tested. Because fire is for refining.

Those not of God will be burnt down. They like to refine gold, refine metals. As oil, they are refined into different kinds of metals, steel, cast iron, and the rest of them. So, God is saying that our foundation is of Christ.

He is, we know from **1 Corinthians 1 verse 30**, He is our redemption. So how can, what are the size of this redemption? So, you understand what this redemption entails when it comes to God's side towards us. And Satan's side towards us. Some of us live in-between. You are one time on God's side, another time on Satan's side. You have to be one side. So, there are two sides to this identification. One of them is legal, one of them is the vital side of it. The legality and the vitality of our redemption. If you understand that concept, it helps you to comprehend a part of your redemption. Which I want to share more through the time. Let's take God's side first.

The first thing about God, let's look at the legal part. The legality of what God did for us. When I talk about legality, I'm talking about what God did for us in Christ Jesus. What God did for us in Christ Jesus. From His death on the cross to resurrection, ascension, and enthronement. The Bible says, in **John 10:10** *The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.* Zoe! The life of God. That which God hath done in Christ Jesus. Its irreversible. He came that we may have life, the life of God. This life should be an ever-flowing life. In **1 John 3, verse 8**, it says” *He that committeth sins is of the devil, for the devil sinneth from*

the beginning for this purpose the sin of God was made manifest, that he might destroy the works of the devil". One of the legality of what God did for us is He sent Jesus Christ to die for us. He did it, and Christ has come and died. Like I said that this period is the period of celebrating and commemorating the crucifixion and death. The burial and resurrection. The ascension and enthronement of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. So, one of the things God did for us is He came to give us abundant life. The very life of His that we once had and we lost. The life eternal. The eternal life of God. It says in **John 17, verse 3**, *That we might know Him as the only true God. And Jesus Christ whom He has sent.*

This is life eternal. This is life eternal. In 1 John 5, verse 11 and 12, And this is a record that God has given us eternal life. And this life is in His Son. He that hath the Son hath life, and he that hath not the Son of God hath no life. He that hath the Son hath life, and he that hath not the Son of God hath no life. The legality of what God has done, that God has legalised, is according to God's signature. The eternal life. Let nobody come and tell you that you have to do some human sacrifices to have eternal life. You must pay some special amount of money. Give some special level of offerings. To attain to God's eternal promised world and eternal life that is given to you and I. You need not do any of those things. God has signed into law. Your salvation. And the vitality of what God has done, talks about what God does in us in Christ Jesus. When we talk about legality, we talk

about what God did **for** us in Christ Jesus and when we talk about vitality, we talk about what God did **in** us in Christ Jesus.

In **2 Corinthians chapter 5**, The Bible says from verse **17 to 21**, *Therefore, if any man, being Christ, is a new creation, a new person, all things are passed away, behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God who has reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ and has given to us the ministry of reconciliation. The way that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not inputting their trespasses into them, but has committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Verse 20, Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ. As though God did beseech you by us, we pray you, in Christ's stead, be you reconciled to God. We have made him to be sin for us who knew no sin. That we might be made the righteousness of God.*

You and I are now new persons, a new creation. We are not going to grow taller, or shorter, or fatter, or thinner. What it does mean is that the person of God is taking hold of your inner spirit. The person of God is taking hold of your being. That your spirit being is now reborn. It's having to think towards God, reason towards God. And experience the nature of God. Eternal life is the life of God. It's the reign of the life of God. It's beyond the realm of the instinct of the five senses. Wherein God's spirit being rules through our own inner spirit. To replicate himself through us, and in us, and for us. In his glory and his power. So, you can see from the context of that scripture, on God's side, in our redemption and

identification. The ability to identify today, of what God did for you in Christ Jesus. What God has done in us in Christ Jesus. God had to crucify his son for our redemption.

If you can identify yourself, see yourself in that crucifixion. See yourself in that death. See yourself in that barrier. In that resurrection. In that ascension. In that enthronement of God in Christ Jesus for your life. You change the horizon of your context and perception of who God is to you. Who you are becoming in Christ Jesus. Otherwise, you'll be living within religion. Under the denomination of creed and bylaws. And the materialism of man. Who will rule you, until you have to make a sacrifice to please God. And make God do things for you. What you need is to come to a point of conception of what Christ has done for you. Identify with it. Make it wholesome in your inner being. It changes your kind of life.

Let me tell you also what Satan's side is. What Satan did to us before God brought us this redemption we are talking about. We know that on the legality of how man fell or Satan tricked man. In Genesis chapter 3, man was deceived and man committed treason. When God spoke to Adam and commissioned him and gave him a wife. God gave him a purpose. And gave him order to oversee the affairs of the earth. God gave him instructions on what to do and what not to do but Adam disobeyed God because Satan tricked him. And he fell into the trap of Satan. So, what Satan did to us. Made us become a rebellion towards God looked at the creation he made to oversee the earth and saw how much he

has fallen. God felt what has really happened. The man I made has fallen so bad. Satan is the reason man fell. But man, the book of Timothy. The woman was deceived but the man wasn't deceived. The man committed treason. He knows what he was doing was wrong. He allowed the wife concept of things to fall for it. That's why we have to have a very strong foundation in Christ Jesus. So, that the little token the devil wants to give to you. Doesn't rob you of who you are. Don't let any man deceive you. Because they are supplying you one help or the other and rob you of your worth in Christ Jesus. Satan did that. And as long as you can identify with that. You become a witness here. And on the other side of what Satan did. We find it in Ephesians **2. Verse 1 to 3**. He said, *and you had it quickened who were dead in trespasses and sins. Wherein time passed, you were walking unto the cause of this world. That's what Satan was doing. According to the prince of the power of the air. The spirit that is now walked in the children of disobedience. Among whom also we will all have our conduct or conversation in time past. In the loss of our flesh. Fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind. And we are by nature the children of wrath. Evil as others.*

That's what's happening today. Anybody who is not of Christ. These are things that happen today. They are governed and ruled by Satan. What gives them joy is what the flesh is telling them. When you identify with God. Your spirit being take hold of you. And rule over your five senses. Meant to respond to the voice of God. Through God's word. The

way you identify with God. Then you identify with Satan. He directs the affairs of your life. He dictates the affairs of your life. Your mood swings. He becomes in charge of them. Eventually. You can still be in the church. They are not enjoying the fullness of God in Christ Jesus. Today. I want you to identify with God. And what he did for you and I in Christ Jesus. And what he does today. To ensure that we enjoy the grace of God. Every single day. I'm going to share more into that in the course of time. What is happening today in our Christian life. What God is doing for us today in our Christian life. So, we can enjoy the fullness of God. As he promised to us. If you identify with God. You don't need any man to stand between you and God. But if you do not identify with God. You will not be like a child who needs to be or a husband who needs to be directed by somebody else. Most of the people today. They don't have their own voice of God. They don't even know God in person. That will depend on somebody to lead them to God. If somebody doesn't pray for them. They can't even talk to God themselves. Identify yourself with what God did for you. In Christ Jesus and also, what God does today. In your life and through your life and with your life. By Christ Jesus as a new Christian as God's ambassador. As a word of consolation by the word of God. You can enjoy the best of God. **2 Corinthians 5.21** says. *That Christ who knew no sin. S-I-N.* The nature of the fall of man. It is a sin. It became that nature and that identification that we can become or have God's righteousness in us.

God's righteousness. I need to stand before God without shame. Without fear. Without intimidation. In wholeness to the glory of his name.

It's my prayer today. Identify with God. In this month of redemption. In the crucifixion. Death. Burial. Resurrection. Ascension and enthronement of our Lord Jesus Christ. The best of God. Rights and privileges. May become yours. Be blessed.

SUMMARY

The message explains the concept of **identification in redemption** — understanding what God did **for us** and **in us** through Jesus Christ and contrasting it with what **Satan did to humanity** through deception.

The preacher emphasizes that **man is a spirit being**, just like God and Satan, and spirit beings **do not die**. Therefore, prayers asking Satan or human enemies to “die” are misguided — instead, we should desire that they live to see God’s power revealed in us.

Redemption, through Christ, restores humanity’s lost inheritance and connection with God. Jesus is the **foundation** of our lives, and anything built outside of Him—whether religion, denomination, or tradition—will not stand the test of time or divine fire.

There are **two sides** to redemption:

1. **God's side** – What God legally and vitally did for us in Christ.
2. **Satan's side** – What Satan did to mankind through deception and sin.

We must consciously **identify with God's side**, living out our redemption in Christ and not under Satan's influence.

Key Teachings & Messages

1. Man, God, and Satan Are Spirit Beings

- Spirit beings cannot die; only the human body can.
- True life is spiritual — man is a spirit, has a soul, and lives in a body.
- Hence, prayers for enemies to “die” miss the true focus of spiritual warfare.

2. Jesus Is Our Foundation in Redemption

- No other foundation can be laid apart from Christ (1 Corinthians 3:11).
- Our lives must be built on Him, not on religious systems or human effort.
- On the final day, every work will be tested by fire — only what's built on Christ will endure.

3. Two Sides of Redemption

(a) Legal Side — What God Did *for Us*

- Through Jesus' **death, burial, resurrection, ascension, and enthronement**, God gave us **eternal life (Zoe)** — His own life.
- This gift is **irreversible** and **requires no human sacrifice or payment**.
- Scriptures: John 10:10, John 17:3, 1 John 5:11–12.
- Our salvation and eternal life are **already signed into law** by God.

(b) Vital Side — What God Does *in Us*

- In Christ, we become **new creations** (2 Corinthians 5:17–21).
- God's Spirit now rules our inner being and renews our nature.
- We are His **ambassadors**, carrying His righteousness and life.
- Eternal life transforms our thoughts, desires, and responses — we now live above the senses and sin.

4. Satan's Side — What Satan Did

- Satan deceived humanity through **the fall in Genesis 3**.
- Adam knowingly disobeyed God, committing **spiritual treason**.

- This act separated man from God and subjected him to the rule of sin and the flesh.
- Ephesians 2:1–3 describes how people outside Christ live under Satan’s influence, guided by worldly desires and disobedience

5. Call to Identify with Christ

- Identification means seeing yourself in:
 - His **crucifixion** (your old nature died),
 - His **burial** (your past buried),
 - His **resurrection** (you are made new),
 - His **ascension and enthronement** (you reign with Him).
- Reject religious dependence on men or rituals to reach God.
- You now have direct access to God — no intermediary needed.
- Identify daily with what Christ **did for you, does in you, and is doing through you.**

The Result of True Identification

- You live in **righteousness**, not guilt or fear.
- You gain confidence before God.
- You enjoy the fullness of His grace and power in daily life.
- You reflect God’s nature and glory on earth.

Final Blessing

As you identify with God through Jesus Christ in His **death, burial, resurrection, ascension.**

You receive the **rights, privileges, and blessings** of redemption.

May you live daily in the fullness of God's life and grace.
