

Message Title: It is the Word that brings our healing.

In continuation of our theme for the month about Preach the Word, I want to share briefly also that it is the Word that brings our healing. When we preach the Word of God, the Word of God produces healing and miracles in our life. The Word of God brings signs and wonders in our life. The Word of God produces a transformation in our life. One thing about the Word of God is that it brings wholeness in our being, completeness in our being. That's what God's Word does. Sometimes I hear people say, or I've read many times, they say time is the healer. But I want to let you know that the Word of God is the healer. The Word of God is the healer. Time is not the healer. I've seen people who have been told with time, we'll be okay with time, everything will be fine. But some people have lived with cuts, lived with pain, lived with injuries. There are some professions, sicknesses, events in our life that lacks our being. There are things that happen to us that are beyond human comprehension. You can't dictate it in the medical notebooks. There are issues in our inner spirit that medicine cannot heal. As a result, people go into depression of all sorts. But when we know God's Word, when you hold to God's Word, when you hear God's Word, when you listen to the Word of God, you can find healing to your soul.

This morning, I want to share probably about three or four scriptures to that light. The first one is **Samuel 7, verse 20**. The Bible says” *He sent His Word and healed them*

and delivered them from their destruction". The Word of God brings healings, brings deliverance from all sorts, spirit, soul, and body. That's what God's Word does. It brings healing to our spirit, healing to our soul, healing to our body. Time can't bring healing to our spirit, soul, and body. Time may momentarily kill some events in our life. But if there's a reoccurrence of events like that, we reflect on the past. When God makes us whole, He kills our spirit, soul, and body. He gives healing to our being. That's why in Christ Jesus, through His Word, we can have a wholesome forgiveness and forgetfulness. But time doesn't make you forget. Time reminds you of events in your life that have happened to you and you don't get healed. Self-accusations, self-pain, self-afflictions, still happen to people today. But this morning I want you to know, today I want you to know, that time is not the healer. What you need for your wholeness in your being is the Word of God. The Bible says in **Matthew 8, verse 16**, An event happened. When Christ, one evening, was ministering. We saw in Matthew 8, verse 16, What does the Bible say? The Word is the healing. It's the Word that brings deliverance to our human life.

Some people are told to make some sacrifices, bring ornaments, until they bring enough bottle of ointment, enough bottle of handkerchief, enough bottle of some sacrifice made, that's the only way I can obtain and receive the healing that comes from God. Those are sacrifices of men. It doesn't produce eternal work of God. If you

want to have complete healing in your being, wholeness in your being, go to the Word of God. The Word that God Himself is speaking to you. The Word of God in the context of what you are going through in your life. I promise you, you can get the Word of God in any context that concerns your personal life. You don't get a healing for that event. You have a wholeness of God in that particular issue. Spirit, soul, and body. God doesn't just heal us on the head and leave what's going on in our stomach, or in our feet, or around our being. When God brings healing, He makes everything whole.

In the Scripture of the Gospels, it says He makes them whole. Spirit, soul, and body. God doesn't just heal you in the eye and leave the rest of your body unhealed.

Time cannot do that, but God brings healing. He sent His Word to bring God healing and miracles, and our life will be transformed by it. That's why the Apostles in **Mark 16, verses 15 to 20**, when He sent them forth to preach the Gospel unto us, we are told, say, these signs, these miraculous signs, shall follow them that believe. They will cast out the devil. They will lay on the sick. They will recover. A lot of stuff we mention there that will happen to us who are believers, who go about to preach the Word of God. It says in verse **20**, when the Apostles took that obedience of God into action, God was confirming His Word, with signs and wonders following. No, His Word. Each time God looks at you and I, He's looking for His Word to act upon. So,

His Word can bring the answers you deserve and the miracles you want Him to do in your personal life.

So, you go to incline to the sayings of God. And finally, in this context, I want to read the book of **Proverbs chapter 4**. Let's look at from **verse 20**. It says, *my son, attend to my words, incline your ear unto my sayings. Let not depart from the eyes. Keep them in the midst of the heart. For they are life unto those who find them, and health to all their flesh*. So, keep their heart with all diligence for out of it are the issues of life. **Verse 22** said, the words of God, the sayings of God which you are listening to, you are giving your ears to, they are life given to them that find them. They are health to all their flesh. Another translation says, they are medicines to the flesh. You want God's eternal walking power in your life. Go to the word of God. Listen to the word of God that brings signs and healing to our body, to our soul, and to our spirit. For man is a spirit being, has a soul and even a body. Scripture tells us that in **Thessalonians 5 verse 23**.

And it says in **Hebrews 4 verse 12-13** Only God's word, He has the power and the sharper than two edges sawed to design to diagnose our spirit, soul and body. The Bible says in verse **13** of that scripture There is no part of our being that is not made manifest before the word of God. Take on God's word today. Get the miracle you

need. It is the word of God that brings healing to our spirit, soul and body. The word heals.

That is why you must preach the word for those who are supposed to be healed. You must receive the word for your own healing. God bless you.

Summary

The message emphasizes that **true healing comes from the Word of God**, not from time, human effort, or man-made sacrifices. While time may dull pain temporarily, only God's Word can bring complete healing — spirit, soul, and body.

When we preach, listen to, and believe the Word, it releases divine power that brings transformation, deliverance, and wholeness. The Scriptures show that God “*sent His Word and healed them*” (Psalm 107:20), and that when the apostles preached, “*the Lord confirmed His Word with signs following*” (Mark 16:20).

The Word of God is life and medicine to all who find it (Proverbs 4:20–22). It penetrates every part of our being, diagnosing and healing what nothing else can reach (Hebrews 4:12). Therefore, believers must *preach the Word, receive the Word, and live by the Word* to experience lasting healing and restoration.

Key Messages

1. The Word, not time, heals:

Time may ease pain temporarily, but only God's Word brings deep, lasting healing to spirit, soul, and body.

2. The Word brings wholeness:

God's Word does not heal partially—it restores every part of our being to completeness.

3. Healing through the Word:

“He sent His Word and healed them” (Psalm 107:20). The Word carries divine power to deliver and make whole.

4. Faith releases the Word's power:

When we hear, believe, and act on God's Word, it produces miracles, signs, and wonders.

5. The Word is life and medicine:

Proverbs 4:20–22 declares that God's Word is *life to those who find it and health (medicine) to all their flesh.*

6. Preach and receive the Word:

Healing flows both when we proclaim God's Word to others and when we personally receive it in faith.

7. The Word searches and heals deeply:

Hebrews 4:12–13 shows that the Word pierces and discerns the thoughts and intents of the heart, bringing total inner healing.

8. Action call:

- Listen to the Word.
- Believe the Word.
- Speak the Word.
- Live by the Word—and healing will manifest.

9. Final reminder:

Preach the Word that others may be healed. Receive the Word for your own healing.
